Marathon Noord is a competition in the Netherlands for fanciers with a distance further than 1030 kilometer from St. Vincent. Only the first two pigeons from the entry list (assigned pigeons) count for this competition. For the midday release championship, the races St Vincent, Dax and Bergerac count. For the Morning release championship Barcelona, Marseille and Perpignan count.

Marathon Noord is a fair competition. Every fancier competes with two pigeons. Further you have to register in advance. So only members can compete. In 2021 we had over 50000€ worth of prizes.

# Wim Peer, Millingen, 1st Champion Midday release Marathon Noord 2021

Champions of Marathon Noord are the best of the best. These Champions are competing and are able to clock one of their first two birds on the entry list on three national races, St. Vincent, Dax and Bergerac. In 2021 St Vincent was a hard race with speeds under 1000 mpm, Dax was less hard, but still...first pigeons arrive just before 10 in the morning. Bergerac was a windy race with arrivals during the night. So three different races. Try to assign the right pigeons for each race with the first two on the entry list.

Wim Peer was able to finish on St Vincent and Dax in the top of the National result lists and Bergerac he also timed early.

## The Fancier

Wim Peer, 74 years old, his profession was building green houses. Nowadays he is the newspaper distributor for his region. This work is done in the early morning hours. When he returns home he takes care of his pigeons.

He started when he was 10 years old together with his brother. In some periods in the 64 years he did not had pigeons because he was not able to.

At present his pigeon loft is 50 meters from his house in the garden of a fancier who was not able to continue with the pigeons due to health issues. He always raced the extreme long distance races.

# The Wim Peer strain

All the pigeons are descendants of the old

Jan Aarden strain. His brother had a hen that flew a 3rd National on Bergerac. This hen is the base hen of the Wim Peer strain. Wim had to stop with the pigeons for a while and sold all his birds to another fancier with one condition: When he was going to start again, he wanted one couple youngsters from this hen. He restarted on his current address and he got the couple of youngsters. One of these is a hen and all the top birds are children or grandchildren of this hen.

### A tiny loft

Wim only has 7 meters or 21 feet of loft. In 2021 he had 12 couples of racers and one breeding couple. He has 28 boxes for the racers but only uses less than half of these. In 2022 the number of breeding couples will be doubled, one of the top racers is promoted to breeder. In another section of the loft is room for 20 youngsters.

The start of 2021 was not very good. Two of his best racers were victim of a bird of prey. His motivation got a big blow, but his daughter motivated him to continue. Wim did continue and how...

### The two birds who did it

The Championship was won by two birds. The '418' and the '02', a granddaughter and a son of the base hen.

St Vincent was the first race which Wim won with Marathon Noord, 13th National on the whole of the Netherlands, 3rd NPO and

On Dax the '02' was the first bird of Wim. The '02' was the 3rd in Marathon Noord and the 3rd NPO. So also a top result.

The hardest race in 2021 for Wim was Bergerac. The '02' returned at 05.27 in the morning after a night of arrivals at a lot of

other lofts, 39th in Marathon Noord was enough to win the Marathon Noord title.

### The year in review

The birds are mated in the end of February. They are basketed on all races on club level to get their kilometers of training. They train twice a day, 30 minutes until 45 minutes forced with a flag or a ball.

Medically they get from the 15th December until the 1st January Baytril. After mating they get their normal Trichomonaise cure and their yearly Paramixo vaccine. When they return from a race he uses Turbo Desinfect of Travipharma. This is about all. Simplicity

rules.
